It was discussed that some traction had been made with connecting with personnel on the campus however there still needs to be work done about reducing stigma associated with condoms and safe sex message by the school's conservative personnel. SCO#84 will be closing shortly. The SCOs (#89 and #93) regarding the health center and the student health fees need to have revised dates. Members expressed the need to know what the policies were for the Los Angeles Community College District as a whole were. It seems each college has its own way of handling sexual health and prevention on their campuses. Members also wanted to know what the scope of work for the health center on campus was.
