Introductions/Review of Previous Minutes and Action Items

SCO #84

- Mauricio met with LACC rep to invite to June meeting and discuss summer plans

LAUSD Update and Brainstorm

- Dave provided an update on the current status of Health Education at LAUSD
- As a group we are charged with identifying and supporting alternative ways to ensure proper Health Education for students.
- Supporting Health education in LAUSD, Partner and Pilot schools can be broken into multiple components:
 - Letters and calls of support
 - Meeting with Officials like Monica Garcia and Steve Zimmer
 - Milton and Dave will keep the group updated on upcoming
 - HIV/AIDS education must be conducted per CA mandate
 - At the very least schools must offer HIV/AIDS education
 - We can work with schools to review and modify curriculum, and also provide appropriate materials. In doing this we can ensure that appropriate and comprehensive materials and lessons are being created
 - Identify schools in South Los Angeles that will be opting out of providing Health Education. A good place to start is with St. Johns affiliated schools. Mauricio will send Daniel Rivas the current SCO information.

Open SCO Check-In

New Structural Change Objectives (Revision to language will be made)

- **GSA Network**
 - **Dave will provide new language to reflect the revision discussed at the meeting**
 - **New SCOs**
 - By May 31, 2013 GSA Network and C2PLA coalition members will provide 80% of LAUSD Gay-Straight Alliances with materials on their rights to an LGBTQ-inclusive sexual health education and HIV/AIDS prevention education under the 2004 state law.
 - By May 31, 2013 GSA Network and C2PLA coalition members will provide students across Los Angeles with information on their legal rights to seek sexual and reproductive health care (including HIV testing) confidentially during school hours without being ticketed for truancy or marked absent.
 - By May 31, 2013 GSA Network and C2PLA coalition members will provide students in 80% of LAUSD Gay-Straight Alliances with referral cards highlighting local, LGBTQ-youth friendly mental and sexual health services.
- **Down Town Magnet High School**
 - **Teresa will set up an appointment with school principal to meet with C2PLA reps.**
 - **NEW SCOs**
 - By April 25, 2013 the Downtown Magnets High School will have six male and female staff members on site that are trained and qualified to distribute condoms to students and parents
 - By January 15, 2013 the Downtown Magnet High School condom distribution program will have a comprehensive marketing plan in place that includes flyers, PA announcements, PSA videos on the DMHS YouTube channel, and various social media outlets.
 - By January 15, 2013 Downtown Magnets High School will have onsite HIV and STI testing at a minimum of once a semester
